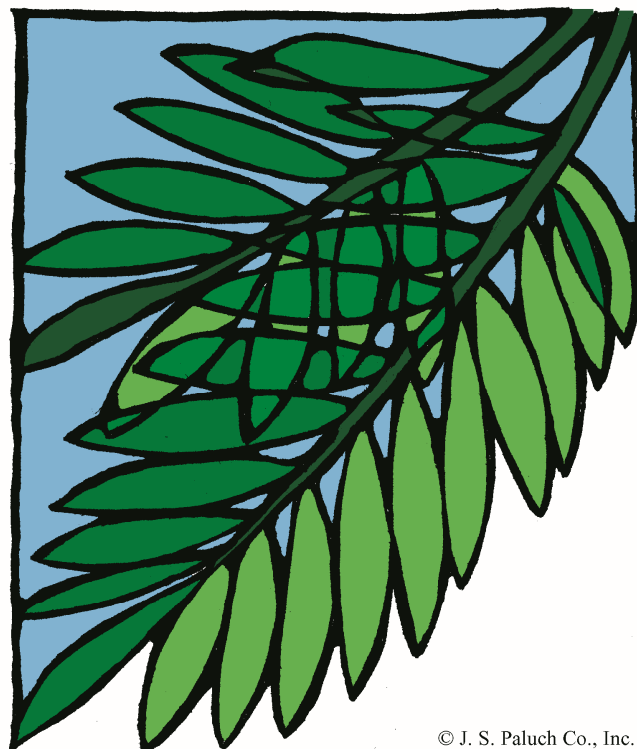

The Pascal Fast

All Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59, are to fast and abstain on Good Friday. All Catholics are encouraged, as a voluntary practice, to fast on Holy Saturday until the celebration of the Easter Vigil.
