Fasting and Abstinence

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to each one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted. Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years of age or older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.

Special Collections

The collection on Ash Wednesday is for the Church in Central and Eastern Europe. It focuses on training seminarians and lay leaders, supports social service programs, schools, church construction and evangelizing through Catholic media.

The second collection next weekend is for Black and Indian Missions. The funds are distributed as grants to dioceses throughout the United States.
