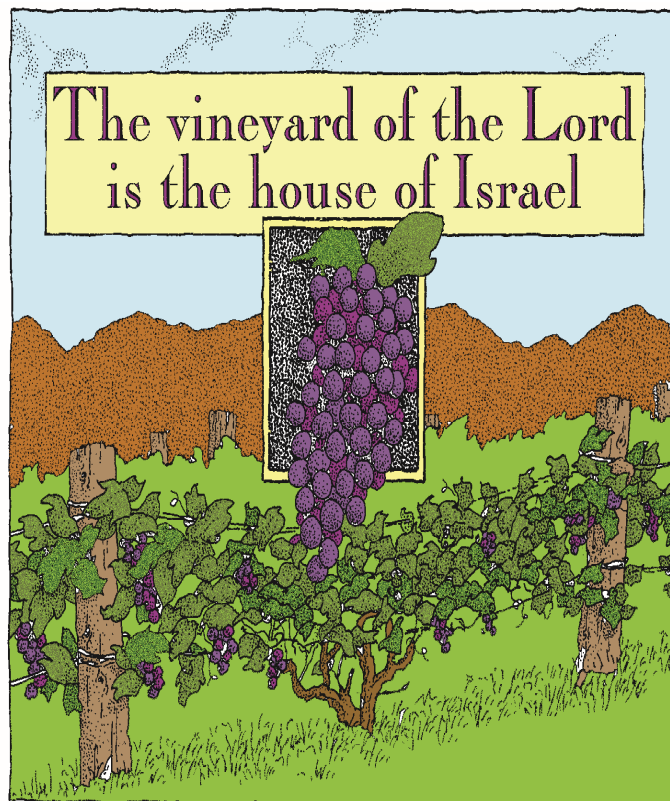

Attention Marshal County Residents

Did you suffer damage in the July flood event? Did you receive assistance from FEMA and still need help? Did FEMA deny your claim? If so, the Long Term Recovery Group (LTRG) of Ohio and Marshall Counties may be able to help.

At this point, there are still Marshall County residents who have not registered through FEMA. All of those affected are urged to register before October 17th. If residents are taking care of the damages on their own, they could still be eligible for assistance no matter how great or small the damage.

If you need additional assistance, you may be eligible for assistance through the LTRG's Unmet Needs Hotline. The main focus of the LTRG is to make sure your home is safe, sanitary and secure.

To be registered for assistance through the LTRG please call 304-233-3850 Monday through Friday between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. You can also email 2017LTRG@gmail.com.

The LTRG will assign you a case manager who will visit your home and help determine ways you may be able to receive assistance.

Remember, we can't help you if you don't call!
