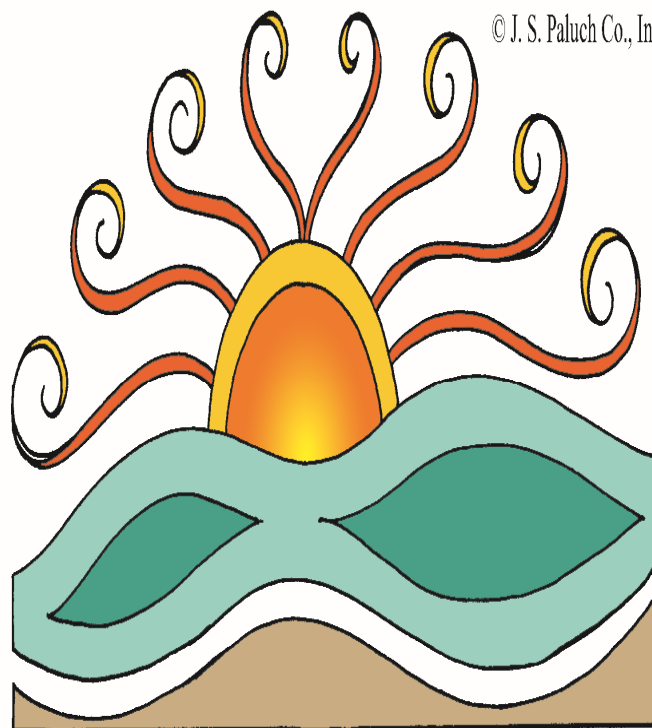

From the Desk of Fr. John Ledford

This weekend we continue our liturgical journey as we come together to share in the celebration of the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. As always, the Sacred Scriptures challenge us to reflect on what we are about. Life is much more than just one's self. What are we about?

In our First Reading we are challenged to look beyond who we are. Here we see Elisha coming into a locality. Based on the reading, it was several times that Elisha made this same journey. Traveler hospitality was most important in the ancient world. There were no Holiday Inns, et al in those days. Hence, it was important that travelers be granted hospitality. Here we see Elisha reaching out to the person. Aren't we challenged to do the same?

Matthew shares a story of Jesus' challenge to the apostles. Jesus is attempted to teach his disciples what it means to be a Christian person. Jesus is getting ready to send them out on their first "missionary" journey. Here, we are challenged by the word "worthy". In this case, the intent of the word is to connote the idea of "equal to, ready," or perhaps "capable". We can see in this an issues that translators face all the time. In any case, doesn't it challenge us to reflect on what we are about as we share our Christian Faith?

UPCOMING EVENTS: This Saturday, 27 June 2020, Deacon Justin Golna was ordained to the Sacred Order of Presbyter for the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston at Saint Joseph Cathedral, Wheeling. Most of us, likely, would refer to his ordination as a priest. This is the only one this year and we have several retirements. It's getting tighter and tighter as we seek to provide ministry to the people of our Diocese. It's something to think about, pray over, and go into action to encourage people to consider ministry for the Diocese.

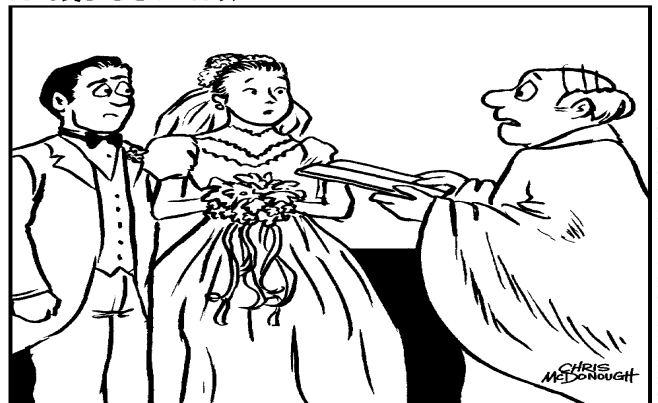
